General Tourist and Sightseeing Information

There is plenty to see and do in Fremantle, such as the Maritime Museum, the Shipwreck Galleries, Fremantle Prison, Fishing Boat Harbour, Fremantle Markets (Friday, Saturday and Sunday), Cappuccino Strip and Victoria Quay. Everything is within easy walking distance from the Esplanade Hotel. Rottnest Island is just a half hour ferry ride from Fremantle.

A visit to Kings Park (Perth) is highly recommended, especially with the wild flowers in bloom. Other points of interest are the Perth Mint, the Bell Tower or a city tram tour.

For extended tours and sightseeing further afield, before or after the Reunion, there are many options. The Margaret River region, in the southwest of WA, is famous for its forests, beaches, caves, surfing, and wineries and, in springtime, its wildflowers. A short trip north of Perth brings you to the Pinnacles desert. If you are lured by gold, a longer trip east to Kalgoorlie and the surrounding goldfields could be of interest.
